The Next Chapter – by Gabrielle

I grew up in a loving Christian home and, although I was only 19 at the time, I found a wonderful Christian man whom I loved and wanted to start my life with. Our plans included finishing school, finding work and beginning our journey and life together. About three months before our wedding, something didn't feel right. I took a home pregnancy test and my heart sank with disbelief when I read the result. My heart was racing, "Maybe it was wrong," I thought. I have never been so anxious and scared in my life.

My thoughts were, "We were supposed to get married and we were supposed to start our lives together. I promised my family I'd finish school. I'm supposed to be an example. I'm too young..."

The thought that haunted me the most, however, was "I'm a Christian, what will other people think?"

Afraid to tell my parents, I tried to find a way I could confirm the pregnancy without involving my family. My fiancée, Cameron and I looked in the phone book and found an ad for FirstChoice Clinic and made an appointment. I couldn't keep it a secret for long; I decided to meet my mom and tell her my news. I was horrified. I started crying before I could even speak.

The guilt I had was unbearable. After I told her the news, she said she would always love me and my family. She said she would help in any way possible. It was harder to tell my father; I was afraid of how he would feel about my fiancée. We talked, hugged and shared tears and I felt like the hardest part was over. Arriving at the clinic the next day, nurse Renae confirmed my pregnancy. She was very positive, never judgmental and helped turn my negative thoughts about how my life would forever be impacted into how the addition of this new life would be a blessing to us. I remember leaving that day feeling, for the first time, a peace about the whole situation.

As my pregnancy progressed, I was often anxious about this baby's dependency on me – would I be a good parent? Cameron and I were encouraged to join the "Earn While You Learn" program at FirstChoice Clinic and, after going through several lessons, we became more confident. Learning how the baby was developing inside of me and what to expect when the baby arrived made us excited to be a part of this baby's life.

Something astounding happened when I was 6 months pregnant. I was watching a movie called, Facing the Giants and it suddenly occurred to me that God had given me – us, a gift in this child. The gift to bring a child into this world, to be a parent – start this part of our journey, just emphasized that God was opening a door for me to come to Him; to grow in my faith and trust in Him. It was very clear...God will give us everything we need in life. I was able to give my guilt to Him and enjoy the rest of my pregnancy.

God has the power to do anything; I could've lost the baby, or had complications, or even let finances bring us down. But His Word promises in 2 Peter 1:3 that, because of His divine power, He will give us everything we need in life. His Word promises He will provide.

Just when we needed it, God provided us with encouragement and educational resources from the staff at FirstChoice Clinic and

the support of family and friends. Because of all of the assistance, Cameron and I feel a bit more confident as the upcoming chapter of parenthood unfolds. Our baby girl Sandra is now eight months old. We thank God daily for this beautiful gift and for the help He continues to send us, support like FirstChoice!

Vote Your Values!

President Bush recently introduced Pope Benedict at the White House by saying: "In a world where some treat life as something to be debased and discarded, we need your message that all human life is sacred, that each of us is willed, each of us is loved and each of us is necessary. In a world where some no longer believe that we can distinguish between simple right and wrong, we need your message to reject this dictatorship of relativism, and embrace a culture of justice and truth". This introduction could not have been more appropriate as we enter into what is probably one of the most important Presidential and Congressional elections in our country's history.

Our vote this year has never been more important. The officials we elect will hold the power to do many things to advance the cause of life. Will our next President appoint judges to the U.S. Supreme Court, open to the causes of life, who will interpret law fairly and honestly regarding those issues? Will our newly elected state officials support life issues like furthering funding for positive alternatives to abortion and Title V funding for abstinence until marriage programs for our schools? Our vote will play an important part of that outcome!

It is so very important that our work is supported by our national and state leaders and is allowed to continue. They need to recognize how important it is for our nation's teens to be given medically accurate information and skills to equip them to make healthy choices

regarding saving sexual expression. They need to recognize the effect of our culture on youth as it continues to be saturated with messages stating otherwise. Look at the success of the movie Juno and the media attention on Jamie Lynn Spears – both instances effectively glamorize teen pregnancy. Massachusetts, a state that has long rejected Title V funding for abstinence education and promotes contraceptive sex education, has the Gloucester Massachusetts teen pregnancy "pact" – a further representation of this serious teen pregnancy problem.

It's time for all of us, you and I and all those we will be electing, to take seriously the many issues facing your young adults today. Our young people deserve a culture that teaches that sex is sacred, that sex should be reserved for marriage, that every human life is sacred from conception to natural death and that means every unborn child is a precious human life. We can do this – we need to elect officials who will stand with us and support life affirming policies.

Here are simple things you can do right now:

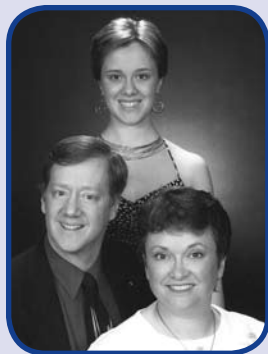

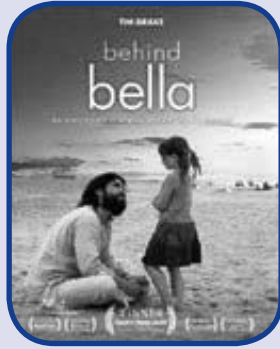

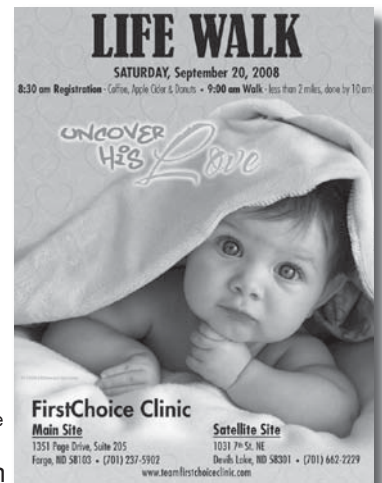
